

Old St. Andrew's Church

The oldest church building in South Carolina, Old St. Andrew's Episcopal Church was built in 1706. The church has withstood wars, earthquakes, hurricanes and other acts of nature; however, over the years the church structure was weakened by these very acts.

In 2006 an extensive preservation/restoration project was completed to correct the damage and to preserve this beautiful historic structure for the worship of Almighty God for generations to come.

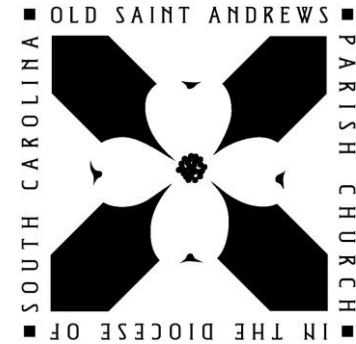

Old St. Andrew's Church was built in 1706. After the Civil War the church was closed until 1948. When it was reopened, the ladies of the church often spent all day cleaning and preparing the church for worship services. Since there were no restaurants in the area, they often brought their lunch and soon began sharing it with the many tourists who stopped to see the church.
