

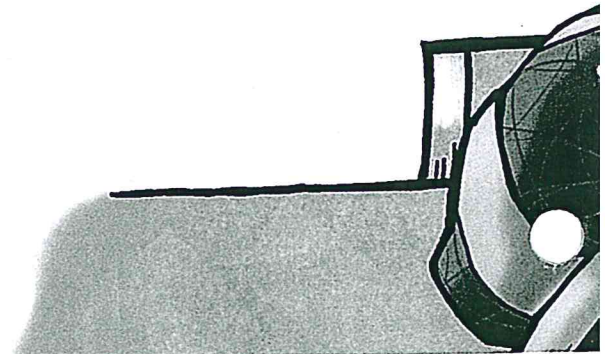
The Chief Priests
